Dear Parents/Guardians,

As discussed in the Year 6 SATs meeting we held on Tuesday (which is still available on our school website: <https://www.stjohnfisherderby.srscmat.co.uk/news/parents-letters/>), we will be holding a series of booster sessions in SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar), Reading and Mathematics to help the children revise previously learnt content and build their confidence in tackling SAT's style questions. These sessions are open to everyone; attendance is expected but not compulsory.

All sessions will start week commencing **24th January 2022**.

The children will bring home a letter on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> January**, showing which sessions/days they have been allocated.

The sessions will run **before** or **after** school and will last around **45 minutes**. Some session will also take place in the school day. In the morning session, children will be provided with toast and a drink before starting their school day. In the afternoon session, children will be permitted to bring a healthy snack and drink.

The children have been grouped to allow them to be supported with areas they need and, therefore, have been assigned a specific group and time. Unfortunately, there isn't the opportunity or flexibility to switch groups or attend another morning or afternoon session. If your child usually walks home, then please let school know if this is how you wish them to get home after their session.

May I take this opportunity to remind you that these assessments are not meant to be stressful, nor are they anything to worry about. We are providing the extra sessions to support all children, who may have missed out over the last 18 months of disrupted education, allowing them to reach their full potential.
