<p>Welcome to our second term in Year 3.</p> <p>Homework will be set on Century and Times Tables Rockstars each week. Your child has a reading record to record their reading and their spelling will be set on Seesaw.</p>		
RE	<p>We follow the Come and See programme and this term there will be 4 topics:</p> <p>Journeys Listening and Sharing Sikhism Giving All</p>	
English	<p>The fiction texts we are sharing this term are "Lost Property" and "Odysseus and the Cyclops". We will also be studying discussion texts and non-chronological reports.</p> <p>Through the Talk for Writing approach, your child will learn these texts, innovating them to write their own texts.</p> <p>Reading books will be changed weekly - please encourage your child to read at least 4 times a week and remember to write this in their reading record so we can celebrate this in class.</p>	
Maths	<p>In Maths our input sessions will explore and teach the following concepts:</p> <p>Multiplication and Division Statistics Length and Perimeter Fractions</p> <p>We are also learning our 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 10 times tables.</p>	
Science	<p>This term in Science we will be covering 2 topics:</p> <p>Light Plants</p>	
History and Geography	<p>This term in History we are learning about Ancient Rome and the Romans. After half term we will be studying Climate and Weather in our Geography lessons.</p>	
PE	<p>Please ensure children wear their PE kit on Wednesdays this term. We will be learning how to play Tag Rugby and a selection of Net/Wall games.</p>	
Art, Design, and Music	<p>Art – We will be learning about the Pointillist art style and creating our own paintings using dots.</p> <p>DT- We will be learning sewing skills to create our own Roman money pouches.</p> <p>Music- Using the Charanga programme we will learn new songs, find and create rhythms, and play tuned and untuned instruments. We will be listening to the songs 'Three Little Birds' and 'The Dragon Song'.</p>
