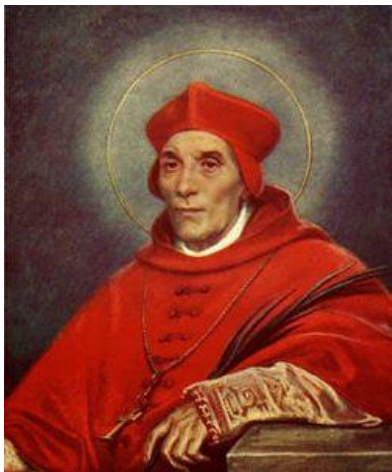
- The Christian life is about journeying with Christ and sharing his way of life. The Church's year celebrates the key elements of Christ's life.

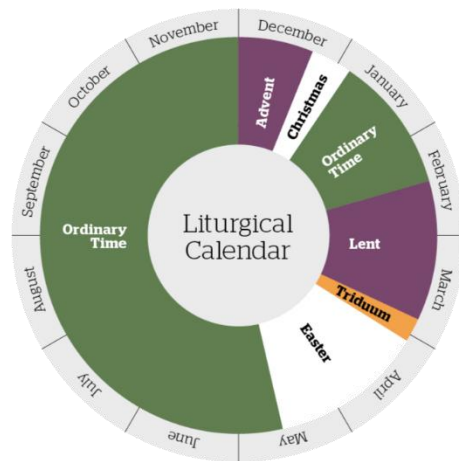

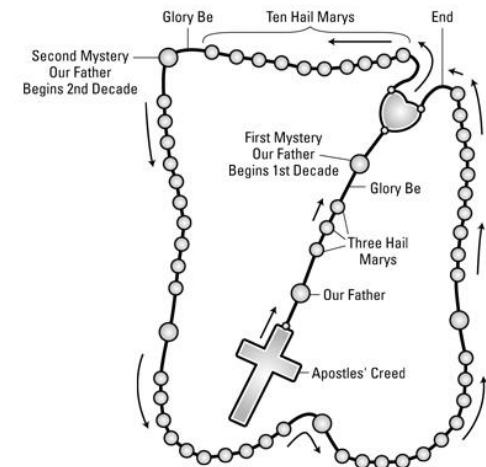

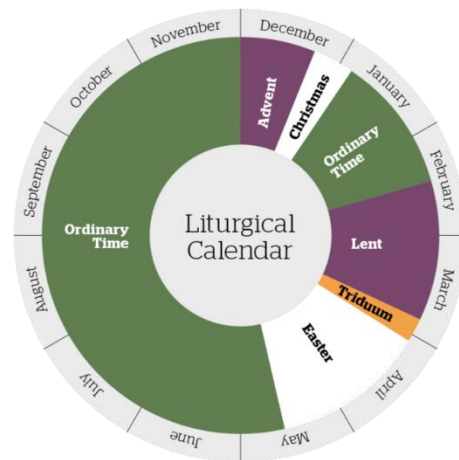
