- I can compare Ancient Egyptian beliefs of the afterlife with Christian beliefs. (Deep)

The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain
"Romanisation" of Britain: sites such as Caerwent and the impact of technology, culture and beliefs, including early Christianity

- I can list many features of Roman culture and beliefs including some myths, legends and gods (Basic)
- I can explain how Roman beliefs changed from belief in many gods to Christianity (Adv)

- I can label Egypt and describe when Ancient Egypt became a powerful nation. (Basic)
- I can explain how the River Nile was vital to the Ancient Egyptians. (Adv)

Lent: The Romans (Revisit)
The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain

- I can summarise how Romans invasion impacted Britain. (Deep)

Advent: Vikings (link to Derby)
the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor

- I can name Derby as a Roman, AngloSaxon and Viking settlement. (Basic)

Advent: Vikings (long boats)
the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor

- I can investigate how the Vikings developed boats that allowed them to travel and explore (Deep)



Pentecost: The Anglo-Saxons
Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots

- I can name King Athelstan as the first King of England in 927 AD. (Basic)
- I can name Derby as a Roman, Anglo Saxon and Viking settlement. (Basic)

Advent: Vikings (invasion)
the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor

- I can explain the impact of Vikings invading monasteries and eventually some settling here. (Adv)

Advent: Vikings (long boats)
the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor

- I can investigate how the Vikings developed boats that allowed them to travel and explore (Deep)

Pentecost: The Anglo-Saxons
Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scot
Roman withdrawal from Britain in c. AD 410 and the fall of the western Roman Empire

- I can explain that after the Roman army left, Britain was invaded by Jutes, Angles and Saxons. I know that there were seven Anglo-Saxon kingdoms. (Adv)

Lent: The Romans (Roman Roads)
The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain

- I can explain the impact of the Romans in Britain building an extensive infrastructure of towns and cities and connecting them with road (Adv)

Lent: The Romans (Boudicca)
The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain

- I can list how the Iceni tribe, led by Boudicca, fought against the Romans. (Basic)

Advent: The Bronze Age
Bronze Age religion, technology and travel, for example, Stonehenge

- I can describe that Neolithic humans built monuments and these help us understand their beliefs. (Basic)

Lent: The Romans (Invasion)
The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain

- I can describe how the Romans invaded Britain and expanded their empire. (Basic)

Advent: Changes between Stone/Iron Age

- I can explain some the changes between the Stone Age and the Iron Age (Adv)
