# Catholic Life:

Following the First Holy Communion Mass at Church over half term, we have planned an opportunity in school for our Holy Communion children to be celebrated in the St Peter and St Paul Mass on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June at 10am. All are welcome to attend.

Children who have made their First Holy Communion this year, whether at English martyrs or another church, are asked to bring along their First Holy Communion outfits with them to school to change into on this day. They should arrive in school in their usual school uniform and we will give them time to change before and after Mass.





Year 3 also went on a wonderful trip as part of our learning about other faiths to the Sikh Gurdwara. It was wonderful to be able to link so may of the key Sikh values to Catholic values – such as kindness and helping others.

## Coming up:

The final half term of the year is always a busy one with so much going on – please do check the dates below to make sure you don't miss anything.

One of the exciting things coming soon is the whole school healthy fortnight. This starts next Monday!

Over the course of this fortnight, all classes will have some additional exercise daily. 
At St John Fisher we are seeking both Foundation and Parent governors.
